Information Architecture/iA Exercise: Map your book in 3 different ways

Making an installation from a book will require you to redesign how the information is presented. Your group's book has an information architecture/structure/organization, which may or may not be represented in a table of contents, index, and/or other means. Using design concepts from Wurman, Applebaum, and/or Bradford, map the book's existing iA and create two *alternative* information architectures for it, and *produce a 2D diagram or poster of each one*. These three diagrams can be hand-drawn, cut-and-pasted together, and/or created on the computer. We will put the diagrams up on the wall and discuss (thus, if you work on the computer, you'll need to print your diagrams out).
